Please note that the Great Britain Tourism Survey is designed as a national and regional survey and is therefore only robust at this level. To improve reliability three year averages have been used in the tables. However, caution should still be used as sample sizes can be low. By way of context, the volume of all overnight trips to England made by GB residents dropped by -9% in 2014 compared to 2013. Those taken for holiday purposes also decreased by -9%, whilst those taken for business fell by -10% against 2013.
